





## MSc (Cons. Biol.) CoE Bursaries for 2011

The Percy FitzPatrick Institute, DST/NRF CoE, is offering up to two CoE bursaries of R50,000 each to South African students registered for the M.Sc. Conservation Biology course at the Percy FitzPatrick Institute at UCT. A precondition of these bursary awards is that you undertake to do your research project using birds as a focus group for addressing a research question in conservation biology, under the supervision of an academic staff member of the Centre of Excellence at the Percy FitzPatrick Institute (these include Tim Crowe, Graeme Cumming, Phil Hockey and Peter Ryan).
